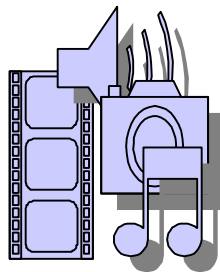

Tarnya Cecchin is collecting broken strings for projects with attendees at the Endeavour Workshops. Please save your broken strings for Tarnya.

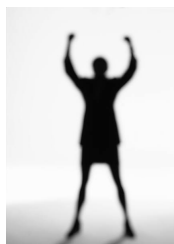
